Core PA Training involves learning to work with children and adapting activities for special needs and situations. You will put your new skills to the test with hands on activities that will prepare you for real life situations working with younger girls at troop, day camp, council and service unit events.

Participants will receive an exclusive GS Swag Bag filled with treasures and ideas to keep any group of youngsters occupied.

Additional Award Requirements: Girl Must earn their Leader in Action (LiA) and help in 6 activities in addition to attending this training. Information about the Award can be found on page 30 of the Cadette Guide to Girl Scouting.
